Using the benefit

Regent offers three different areas of cover:

- Area 1 is for travellers to the Indian Ocean, Africa, the Far East and the Middle East.
- Area 2 is for travellers to Australasia and Europe.
- Area 3 is for travellers to North America, Central and South America and the Caribbean, as well as Areas 1 and 2.

For extra protection, you can buy additional cover. For example, if you are travelling to Area 1, you will boost your cover significantly by buying cover for Area 2 or 3. However, you cannot downgrade your cover by buying a less comprehensive policy – so, if you are travelling to Area 3, you cannot buy cover for Area 1 or 2.

An age limit of 65 applies to all people buying cover. However, Regent Travel Insurance also offers Senior Cover for travellers (aged 66-80) to certain areas. Travellers to Area 2 may top up their protection by buying this cover.

You must pay with a valid MasterCard or Visa cheque or credit card.

Regent may not provide cover for claims relating to the following pre-existing medical conditions: hypertension, heart conditions, breathing conditions (asthma), cancer, pregnancy, age limit exceeded, gastrointestinal conditions and diabetes.

All claims exceeding R2 000 must be approved by Regent Travel Insurance's service provider prior to incurring the expenses.

Claims may be excluded if you participate in high-risk activities, manual labour or travel to a country where the FCO has advised against travel. Please check with Regent Travel Insurance before you travel.
